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Statutory multiplications

Count in 2s, 5s and 10s	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables.	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables.	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12x12.

By the time the children finish Year 4, they should be able to recall all multiplication and division statements in the 2, 5, 10, 3, 4, 8, 11, 6, 12 and 7 times tables (multiplication within 6 seconds) to achieve 'working at the expected standard' in Maths. Throughout the year, we will practise during our four times a week Multiplication lessons. On a Friday, we will check the children's knowledge during our independent lesson. Please support your child by practicing the weekly multiplication and division statements at home for a minimum of 10 minutes every day.

Year 4 Multiplication Check

The multiplication tables check (MTC) is statutory for primary schools. The purpose of the MTC is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently. It will help schools to identify pupils who have not yet mastered their times tables, so that additional support can be provided.

The MTC will take place in June 2026 and will be administered on computers and ipads. The child will have 6 seconds to answer the multiplication statement and type the answer in. There will be no division statements in the check.

Termly Progress Checks

Children in Years, 2, 3 and 4 will be tested at the end of each half term. The tests will follow the format of the Year 4 Multiplication Check which has 25 questions and is timed. Timings for each year group will be communicated to parents so that practice at home can be of a similar nature. For instance, the official Year 4 check allows children 6 seconds per question with 3 seconds in between each question. Each term, parents will receive a report with their child's score out of 25.

TT Rockstars

Please logon to TT Rockstars daily to practise the set multiplications. The 'garage' section is where your child will be able to practise the set mutliplifications for the week. Please also visit the 'soundcheck' section at least once a week to try out the mixed multiplications up to 12x12 with a 6 second time limit. This is very similar to the MTC that your child will be taking in June.
